NOMINATION OF FELLOWS OF NSM

In accordance with Clause 4(g) of the Rules of the Nutrition Society of Malaysia, members may nominate their colleagues to be elected as Fellows of the NSM.

Clause 4(g), *“Fellow members shall be elected at a General Meeting, on the recommendation of the Council for outstanding professional and meritorious contributions to the field of nutritional sciences. Fellows of the Society will be entitled to use the abbreviation, FNSM, after their names.”*

Nominations should be made to the Council of NSM accompanied by a two-page biodata to the President of NSM. Members to be nominated as Fellows must meet the criteria stipulated below. All nominations shall be reviewed by the Council and if found appropriate shall be tabled for decision by members present at the Annual General Meeting.

Criteria for nomination as Fellows of NSM:

1. Life or Ordinary Member of the Nutrition Society of Malaysia (NSM).
2. Outstanding and meritorious contributions to the field of nutritional sciences as indicated by:
 - a. Nutrition research projects/programmes
 - b. Publications
 - c. Consultations (including Working Groups / Technical Committees)
 - d. Inventions / Innovations / Patens
 - e. Awards
 - f. Community service
3. Regular contributions to or support of the activities of the NSM for at least 10 years.
